• About Harbin



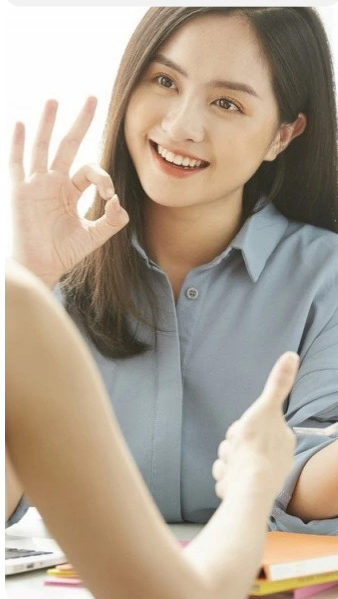
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

The most northeast capital city in China; Known as Oriental Paris or Ice City.



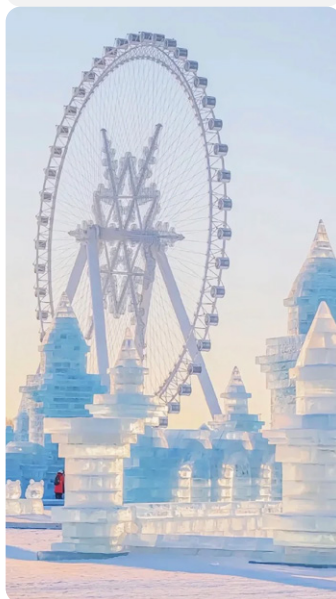
LANGUAGE ADVANTAGE
